



SENIOR BRITISH MINISTER VISITS DP WORLD'S FLAGSHIP

Dubai, 15 February 2010: Lord Peter Mandelson, the British Secretary of State for Business Innovation and Skills yesterday toured DP World's flagship Jebel Ali terminal and met with HE Sultan Ahmed Bin Sulayem, Chairman of Dubai World and DP World.
